Where do I send my tape?

You may also submit either your original tape, or a copy of the funny or unusual clip on a separate tape or DVD. Please remember we are not responsible for lost, damaged, or misdirected tapes, so if your tape is very valuable to you, you should send us a copy. You may submit more than one funny clip on a single videocassette. Please include a brief description of the video clip and try to cue the cassette up to the funny part. Make sure you include your name, address, and phone number with the cassette. If you wish to have your tape returned, enclose a check or money order made out to Golf Channel in the amount of \$3.00.

What is the status of my tape?

Your release forms and a copy of your clip will remain in our system indefinitely. When we build shows, we are constantly reviewing and reconsidering material that has come to us since day one. Therefore, there is a good chance your clip will find it's way into a show, even if you haven't heard from us in a while.

PROCEDURES

1. Persons wishing to enter should send as many different home videos as they wish to: Amazing Golf Videos, 7580 Commerce Center Drive, Orlando, FL 32819. Videos will be reviewed on an ongoing basis..
2. Entrants should include their return address and telephone number and a brief written description of the videos being submitted.
3. All entries become the sole property of Golf Channel and may be used in any manner in all media. Entrants by mail should include a \$3.00 handling fee per video, in U.S. money order, if they wish Golf Channel to return their video(s), which will be done on a rolling basis during the 2008 season. Golf Channel reserves the right to destroy all videos for which a request for return and the handling fee were not sent at the time of submission. Golf Channel is not responsible for lost, damaged or misdirected videos under any circumstances. Please keep a copy of your submission.
4. All home video formats are acceptable (VHS, 8MM, Hi-8, digital video). Home videos shot for commercial purposes are not eligible for any prizes. Home videos transferred to DVD or CD-ROM will be accepted provided they meet eligibility and broadcast requirements. 8MM film transferred to videotape is also accepted. Digital chips will not be accepted.
5. Videos that purport to be spontaneous must be so, or entrant must explicitly disclose the circumstances of the taping at time of entry.

6. Golf Channel reserves the right to edit and/or alter any submission.

7. Golf Channel decisions regarding all contest matters are final and nonappealable. All submissions are subject to the terms of these rules and all entrants agree to be bound by these rules and Golf Channel decisions. Golf Channel reserves the right to amend these rules at any time and Golf Channel will post the rule changes on Golf Channel.com. The rules in effect at whatever time the submission is judged will apply regardless of submission date.

8. Golf Channel reserves the right to alter the number of contestants in each show and the number of shows at any time.
